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To whom it may concern,

In compliance with the requirements of the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Accreditation Council (ANMAC) I am writing to confirm that Mr Pete Lorenz Bisain Carnay (DOB: 29/11/1988) worked as an agency Perioperative Registered Nurse at Royal Surrey NHS Trust operating theatres. Pete was employed from the period of 18/3/2024 to 02/09/2024 through his agency Globe Locums. Pete worked a total of 625 hours within this period.

The Royal Surrey NHS Foundation Trust is a multi-site acute and community Trust, based in Guildford, which serves a population of more than 500,000 across southwest Surrey; and a tertiary cancer centre, offering state of the art diagnostic and treatment services to a population of two million. 90,000 patients are admitted for treatment, around 78,000 patients attend our Emergency Department, and we deliver around 3,000 babies each year. There are 14 dedicated surgical theatres including major oncology and an emergency theatre which runs 24/7 365 days a year.

Pete worked for the Royal Surrey Hospital in the capacity of an anaesthetic practitioner. Pete was an excellent member of our anaesthetic team with a great work ethic. Clinically he undertook all specialities and worked with adults and paed. He is competent in difficult airway lists, major HPB and gynae oncology as well as being part of our emergency team in our CEPOD theatre. He works to a high standard, although not a substantive member of staff he worked to the level of a senior anaesthetic practitioner band 6.

In relation to ANZSCO code 254423- Perioperative Nurse, Pete carried out the following roles and responsibilities while employed with us:

- To work in accordance with the Trust's Values to consistently demonstrate the behaviours required. The post holder is required to carry out his/her role in accordance with the organisation values, standards and behaviours, in a Professional, Compassionate, Respectful and Safe way.
- Supervise junior staff, participate in orientation, supervision and the training of learners, and support workers.
- Assist anaesthetists, surgeons, and other healthcare professionals during surgical procedures, including airway management and monitoring of patients.
- Participate in emergency procedures, responding swiftly and efficiently in critical situations.

- Maintain accurate patient records and documentation in line with hospital policies and legal requirements.
- Prepare and maintain theatre environments, equipment, and instrumentation to ensure patient safety and infection control.
- Strong clinical skills with the ability to work autonomously and as part of a team, and when required to, lead the team.
